REQUIREMENTS FOR THE REPORTS

The paper should be presented in Russian or English on an A4-size format (21x29,7) and should not exceed 2 pages. Page margins: left – 2,5 cm, right – 1,0 cm, top – 1 cm, bottom – 1,5.

Line spacing: single.

Font type: Times New Roman, 11 pt, align – justify.

Title: 12 pt, bold, capital letters, align – center, without abbreviation.

Title should firstly be followed by surname and initials of each reporter and secondly by surname and initials of research adviser (11 pt, bold, align – left); the next line: university, city, country (11 pt, align – left).

The illustrations must be black and white only and suitable for scale reduction. Please note that photos and filled-up illustrations are not allowed. The Organizing For typing formulas the Microsoft Equation Editor 3.0 is to be used.

File format:

.doc (Word for Windows, with Word 6.0 or 7.0 – MS Office 97 support).
